St BURYAN HEAVY METAL SIX-BELL STRIKING COMPETITION

The competition will be held at St. Buryan on Saturday 6th July starting at mid-day and is open to all bands to compete.

The competition will have 2 sections.

1. Heavy Metal 6 Bell Call Change Competition.
2. National 6 Bell Method Ringing Competition.

Prizes are in the form of certificates and cups.

The rules of the competition are as follows:

- 1 This competition is open to all bands.
- 2 A ringer may take part in more than one band, but no more than three bands.
- 3 Each competing band must submit an entry form (see bottom of Rules for entry form), by 27th June to the District Secretary on steve.penhaligon@btinternet.com
- 4 Test pieces will be:
 - a. Call Changes: 34 changes in the call change section, either the front end or the back end of the Devon Competition Peal (see the attached two call change lists).
NB There is to be no Rise & Fall.
 - b. Method Section: 240 changes, either doubles or minor. Details of the touch must be submitted to the organiser before the test piece is performed.
- 5 A maximum of 5 minutes practice will be allowed prior to the test piece. This does not need to be continuous.
- 6 When ready to start the test piece, give two whole pulls of the Treble.
- 7 Call changes may be open or closed hand stroke leads provided this is consistent. Method ringing must have open hand stroke leads.
- 8 Timing, and number of changes will be refereed by a timekeeper in the tower.
- 9 Judging will be by appointed persons, and their decision is final.
- 10 There will be an entry fee of £2.00/rope. A separate charge will be made for tea.
- 11 Entries and numbers for tea are to be submitted to the organisers by Thursday 27th June on steve.penhaligon@btinternet.com

- 12 Order of ringing within each section will be determined by a draw to be carried out by Saturday 29th June 2024. Bands will then be notified of an approximate time of ringing by 3rd July. Any band which does not notify the District Secretary of their intention to compete by 27th June will be allocated a time at the end of each particular section.
- 13 The organisers of the competition are the District Secretary and Ringing Master, to whom all enquiries should be addressed.
